



### **Dobby Weaving**

Ideal for checks, stripes, and our signature diamond stoles, Dobby looms bring elegance to every thread.

### **Jacquard Weaving**

For complex, custom patterns, Jacquard looms allow creative freedom and precise detailing.

### **Ikat Weaving**


An ancient dye-resist technique that creates vibrant, double-sided patterns—loved by our global customers.

# KNITTING

Knitting is where our journey began over two decades ago—to meet the demand for luxurious cashmere while preserving the rich tradition of hand knitting. This entirely handmade process gives each garment its unique charm and character. From fiber to the finished piece, every step is carefully monitored to ensure perfection. Our workforce, primarily composed of skilled women knitters and menders, brings an unparalleled attention to detail, earning us a distinguished place in the cashmere community. We have come a long way and remain committed to refining these techniques, expanding our reach, and sharing our craftsmanship with a larger audience. 
# PRINTING

Traditionally, prints have always been a key element in enhancing the charm of fabric. Our products pass through the hands of skilled printers who add elegant designs and patterns, further elevating the fabric's appeal. We employ two distinct printing methods: traditional screen printing and modern digital printing. In screen printing, singlecolor screens are overlaid one after another on the fabric to form the design. Digital printing, on the other hand, uses advanced computer technology to print directly onto the fabric, much like a printer prints on paper, offering more intricate and vibrant designs.

Our aim is not only to print beautiful patterns but also to leave a positive impact on nature. By using azo-free dyes and eco friendly chemicals, we ensure that all of our prints are environmentally responsible and sustainable.

A radiant alignment of the seven energy centers, designed to restore harmony, balance, and flow — energy you can wear.




